
8TH ANNUAL BOWL FOR HUNGER







Holy Places

Recently I sat down to write an article for this month's newsletter, and as I picked up a notebook to begin writing, a piece of paper fell out. I picked it up and began to read it, and it was a poem I had written shortly after worshipping at the Abbey in Iona, Scotland in 2012. I had forgotten about the poem, but on this day it reemerged. I thought maybe there was a reason it fell at my feet, and perhaps I ought to share it.

We had just been to worship at the Abbey. It was about 10 o'clock at night, but it was just turning dusk in a land that is situated so far north. The glow of the Abbey cast a stream of golden light on the path ahead of us. About that time, someone said, "Come and see the dolphins playing in the bay." It was one of those moments that is frozen in time. Whenever I need strength, I revisit that holy night, and it all comes back. Later that night when we got back to the room, I wrote a poem about the experience, and this is what emerged. I hope you have a holy place or moment in your life where you can revisit and be reminded of God's presence and grace.

My Work Today

Today my work will be to walk on sacred soil. My job will be to climb your hills and gaze upon Colomba Bay, and when the evening comes, I'll watch the dolphins play. My work will be to worship, and watch the candles burn.

Today I would fall on my knees upon your chapel floor. I would not leave until I was blessed, and never ask for more.
