



# "In everything give thanks, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." 1 Thessalonians 5:18



As we near the season of Thanksgiving, perhaps it is a good time to ask the question we should be asking everyday — What are you thankful for? Giving thanks is not so much an observance of a holiday as it is an attitude and way of life. I have noticed that people who live with gratitude and appreciation for what God has given are more likely to be hopeful and optimistic about their life than those who do not. After all, just look what God has done for

you in the past. Giving thanks leads to a lifestyle. What God wants is a grateful heart that leads to a grateful life.

I love the song, "Give Thanks." The beginning words are:

Give thanks with a grateful heart Give thanks to the Holy One, Give thanks, because He's given Jesus Christ, His Son.

Need we say any more? Giving thanks is based on the joyful fact that God has given us Jesus Christ, His Son. Everything else flows from that reality. Sometimes when things are going well we forget to thank God and give Him the credit. Perhaps we think that we are the source of our own prosperity and success. But thankfulness has little to do with our material situation in life, but rather our relationship with the One who blesses us.

The Biblical view of thanksgiving is a way of looking at life where God is at the center of all that we are and all that we have. It's a perspective that changes how we look at everything else in life — that God comes first and is in charge of our life. So a sense of thanksgiving becomes a lifestyle and flows from our relationship with God. Rabbi Abraham Heschel once said, "If the only prayer we ever pray is 'thank you,' it is enough." At least for us it should be a place to begin.

On this Thanksgiving, why not ask Jesus to be a guest at your table and in your home? What difference would that make in your Thanksgiving celebration? In this season of life I am trying to be grateful for blessings large and small every day. The more I do that the more I can see God at work in all things. I had a colleague and friend who had a standard answer whenever someone asked him how he was. Kelmo always said with a smile, "I'm blessed brother! I'm blessed!" How about you? Are you blessed? This Thanksgiving and every day, may we be able to say the same thing.
