# Happy Leap Year 2024!

2024 is a leap year, which means we will have 29 days this February. The next leap year will be 2028. It takes Earth about 365.25 days to orbit the Sun, but the Gregorian calendar does not take into consideration the extra quarter day. If we did not add an extra day every four years, the calendar would be off by 5 hours, 48 minutes, and 45 seconds yearly, according to the Farmer's Almanac. This means that the seasons would be off by 25 days after a century. People born on February 29 are known as "leaplings". Weather folklore says that the weather always changes on Friday in a leap year. In leap years past, Rome burned, the Titanic sank, Ben Franklin proved lighting is electricity, and gold was discovered in California.

"So we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another." Romans 12:5 ESV

"...you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ." 1 Peter 2:5 ESV

What makes a church a church? In this season of constant changes, we ought to know what is it that makes us who we are.

Is it the building? Our own charter predates the building by two whole years so that can't be it. Is it the minister? It better not be, because we have had dozens of ministers shepherd our church for our nearly 160 year existence.

We must remember that Jesus's church is His "called out assembly."
