
INK CARTRIDGES RECYCLE

God is good and supplies all our needs.



Psalm 104

- <u>1</u> Praise the LORD, my soul. LORD my God, you are very great; you are clothed with splendor and majesty.
- 2 The LORD wraps himself in light as with a garment; he stretches out the heavens like a tent
- $\underline{3}$ and lays the beams of his upper chambers on their waters. He makes the clouds his chariot and rides on the wings of the wind.
- 4 He makes winds his messengers, flames of fire his servants.
- 5 He set the earth on its foundations; it can never be moved.
- $\frac{6}{6}$ You covered it with the watery depths as with a garment; the waters stood above the mountains.
- $\underline{7}$ But at your rebuke the waters fled, at the sound of your thunder they took to flight;
- <u>8</u> they flowed over the mountains, they went down into the valleys, to the place you assigned for them.
- **9** You set a boundary they cannot cross; never again will they cover the earth
- $\underline{10}$ He makes springs pour water into the ravines; it flows between the mountains.
- 11 They give water to all the beasts of the field; the wild donkeys quench their thirst.
- $\underline{12}$ The birds of the sky nest by the waters; they sing among the branches.
- 13 He waters the mountains from his upper chambers; the land is satisfied by the fruit of his work.
- <u>14</u> He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate—bringing forth food from the earth:
- <u>15</u> wine that gladdens human hearts, oil to make their faces shine, and bread that sustains their hearts.
- 16 The trees of the LORD are well watered, the cedars of Lebanon that he planted.
- <u>17</u> There the birds make their nests; the stork has its home in the junipers.
- 18 The high mountains belong to the wild goats; the crags are a refuge for the hyrax.
- 19 He made the moon to mark the seasons, and the sun knows when to go down.
- $\underline{\underline{20}}$ You bring darkness, it becomes night, and all the beasts of the forest prowl.
- **21** The lions roar for their prey and seek their food from God.
- 22 The sun rises, and they steal away; they return and lie down in their dens.
- 23 Then people go out to their work, to their labor until evening.
- <u>24</u> How many are your works, LORD! In wisdom you made them all; the earth is full of your creatures.
- <u>25</u> There is the sea, vast and spacious, teeming with creatures beyond number—living things both large and small.
- **26** There the ships go to and fro, and Leviathan, which you formed to frolic there.
- 27 All creatures look to you to give them their food at the proper time.
- $\overline{28}$ When you give it to them, they gather it up; when you open your hand, they are satisfied with good things.
- 29 When you hide your face, they are terrified; when you take away their breath, they die and return to the dust.
- <u>30</u> When you send your Spirit, they are created, and you renew the face of the ground.
- 31 May the glory of the LORD endure forever; may the LORD rejoice in his works—
- <u>32</u> he who looks at the earth, and it trembles, who touches the mountains, and they smoke.
- <u>33</u> I will sing to the LORD all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live.
- <u>34</u> May my meditation be pleasing to him, as I rejoice in the LORD.
- 35 But may sinners vanish from the earth and the wicked be no more. Praise the LORD, my soul. Praise the LORD.


16th Annual **Bowl for Hunger**
